- Under **Goals & Plans** create at least one plan.
- **Explore Options:** Choose a career profile, save it and rate the "Important Factors" for that career; start to explore programs and majors.
- Check out the SAT Practice Khan Academy link directly on your Xello homepage under **Links & Resources**. You can even link your College Board & Khan Academy accounts to give you personalized practice options!
