

IN-PERSON LEARNING

Grades Pre-K through 12



Synchronous Learning: Students and teachers log into Google Classroom at a specific time and work together virtually.

Asynchronous Learning: Students participate in learning activities on their own time without live instruction.

Instruction for In-Person Learning (Elementary and Special Education)

Students will receive five (5) hours of instruction each school day. Three of these hours will be in person at school. Students are expected to complete an additional two hours, daily, of asynchronous learning activities.

Asynchronous Learning: Students participate in learning activities on their own time without live instruction.

Bus Riders

An adult must walk with their child to the bus stop. Bus riders will have their temperatures taken and asked screening questions at their bus stop. Students not passing the screening will not be allowed to enter the bus. The bus garage will be mailing specific drop-off and pick-up times.

Walkers

Walkers will have their temperatures taken and asked screening questions prior to entering the school. Parents will be contacted for students not passing the screening.

Car Riders

Students must remain in the car until a staff member takes their temperature, asks screening questions and approves the

student(s) to enter the building. Students not passing the screening will be asked to remain in the car and taken home.

Meals During School

Some meals will be served in classrooms. Students in the morning session will be offered a pre-packaged breakfast to enjoy in the classroom. They will be sent home with a sack lunch. Students in the afternoon session will be offered lunch upon arrival and will be provided a pre-packaged breakfast when they leave to be used for the next day. Students in the afternoon group may bring a sack lunch from home.

Field Trips and Back-to-School Events

Masks and Social Distancing

When possible, we are to maintain social distancing (six feet apart).

Everyone must always wear a mask when inside the building. Students may wear a mask from home, or a mask will be provided. Children will learn how to properly wear a mask and wash their hands. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes will be available in all classrooms and offices.

When a Child Becomes Ill

If a child becomes ill while at school, parents will be contacted immediately to pick-up their child. Staff will not transport students. There is a separate room designated for students who exhibit symptoms that could be COVID related. We will follow IDPH guidelines regarding timelines for students to return.

Visitors

Parents/guardians, and visitors will be allowed in the building for emergency situations only. Regretfully, parents/guardians will not be allowed to take children to class this year.
