

REMOTE LEARNING

Grades Pre-K through 12



Synchronous Learning: Students and teachers log into Google Classroom at a specific time and work together virtually.

Asynchronous Learning: Students participate in learning activities on their own time without live instruction.

Remote Learning

District 118 licensed teachers will utilize district curriculum to instruct students.

Schedules

Students will participate in daily scheduled class times with their teachers. Students are expected to complete an additional two hours, daily, of assigned learning activities on their own time. Each specific school's remote learning schedule will outline student support hours.

Northeast Grades 5 and 6 Student Remote Learning Schedule

Synchronous online class time: 8:00 a.m. – 1:45 p.m.

Students are expected to complete an additional two hours, daily, of asynchronous activities.

Southview Upper Elementary Student Remote Learning Schedule

Synchronous online class time: 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Students are expected to complete an additional two hours, daily, of asynchronous activities.

Synchronous online class time: 8:00 a.m. – 1:45 p.m.
